2.1. INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR 2015

The Resource Persons included- Prof. Leon Monroe Miller, Talinn University of Technology, Estonia, Prof. Dr. Hayley Stevenson, The University of Sheffield, UK., Ms. Anju Sharma, Director, Oxford Climate Policy, Oxford, United Kingdom, Dr. Mukunda Dev Behera, Indian Institute of Technology, Kharagpur, Dr. Ravi P. Bhatia, Retired Professor Delhi University, Prof. D. Parthasarathy, Indian Institute of Technology, Bombay, Prof. Sudhir Chella Rajan, Indian Institute of Technology, Madras, Dr. M . A. Department of Chemistry

The Dept. in 2015 undertook a departmental project on "A study on the detection, toxicity and some bio-chemical aspects of heavy metals with special reference to the effluents coming from Union Christian College and Shillong into the Umiam Lake".
