1. COLLEGE ACTIVITIES (2016-17)

Last Year's College Annual Foundation Day was celebrated in full spirit and enthusiasm with the presence of Rev D.C Haia. Academic Awards were also handed to students and Staffs from the Various Dept. who excelled in the NEHU Final Examination 2015.

1.3. Faculty Development Programme 2016

The College in collaboration with the United Board for Christian Higher Education in Asia, Hong Kong on 27th- 30th September 2016 at Union Christian College, Umiam Khwan Meghalaya organised a three-day Faculty Development Programme on "Christian Higher Education in North-East India". The objective of the meeting is to promote Christian higher education in North-East India so as to meet the needs and aspirations of Christian Colleges. Dr. M. Spurgeon, Associate Professor, Madras Christian College, Dr. Jayakar Chellaraj, Former Principal, Bishop Heber College, Trichi, Dr. Radha Mohon, Former Principal Rajalakshmi College of Education, Chennai were the Resource Persons in the Programme. The Programme was attended by faculty from the Christian Colleges of North- East India.

1.4. US Fulbright Specialist Program on Social Forestry 2017

The College through the Department of Botany and Zoology in collaboration with Prof. Warren Keith Moser, Rocky Mountain Research Station, Arizona, United States of America from the US Fulbright Specialist Program conduct mapping of Botanical Garden, Herbal Garden in the college.

1.5. Study Tour to Madurai

The College hallmark is its Cultural plurality representing the states of North-east India. Different Cultural programs were organized from time to time by the Student's Council highlighting the Cultural Diversity of the Region. Recently, the College Cultural team showcased the Culture of the region through its special item at the Golden Jubilee Celebration of the All India Association for Christian Higher Education which was held at Madurai in October 2016 and was awarded 'Best Cultural Items'.

1.6. Documentation of Herbal Garden

Mr. Vivek Kumar (Independent Researcher and General Secretary, Meghalaya Futurity Society) who has commendably worked in documenting the Medicinal Plants Species conserve within the College Herbal Garden and the Book was published in 2017.

1.7. Donation to Synod Sepngi

The G.B unanimously approved to sanction Rs. 30,000/- towards the victims of the tragic accident during the K.J.P Synod Sepngi Meeting as a token of condolence.

1.8. NSS Republic Day Parade
